Subject: Appointment of Interim City Manager
Requested Action or Motion: Move to appoint Mark Reggentin City Manager for an interim period with all the powers and duties described in Maitland Charter Section 4.04; provided that the appointment will expire on the earlier of (1) the City Council's appointment of a City Manager of indefinite term, or (2) the day that is 180 days from today; and provided further that Mr. Reggentin's compensation during the interim period will be equal to that of the late City Manager's.
Summary Explanation & Background: The City Charter requires that the City Council appoint a City Manager as chief administrative officer with the powers and duties described in section 4.04 of the Charter. This appointment is critical to the functioning of the City. Recent unfortunate events have left the City without a City Manager. The job description of Assistant City Manager Mark Reggentin requires that he perform the functions of City Manager in the absence of the City Manager. However, the Charter does not provide for one to perform as "acting City Manager," except in cases of the City Manager's "temporary absence or disability." Mr. Reggentin is able and willing to perform the duties of City Manager. It is recommended that the City Council appoint Mark Reggentin as City Manager for an interim period with all the powers and duties appertaining to that position as described in Section 4.04 of the City Charter, provided, however, that the appointment will expire on the earlier of (1) the City Council's appointment of a City Manager of indefinite term, or (2) the day that is 180 days from today; and provided further that Mr. Reggentin's compensation during the interim period will be equal to that of the late City Manager's. It is understood and expected that in the coming months, the City Council will commence and conclude an appropriate search for a City Manager of indefinite term. It is further understood that nothing in Mr. Reggentin's appointment, including its expiration, will prejudice his employment status with the City.
