I. CALL TO ORDER

Present: 4 - Councilmember Lori Wurtzel, Councilmember Michael Wilde, Vice-Mayor Lindsay Hall Harrison, Mayor John Lowndes

Absent: 1 - Councilmember Vance Guthrie

Mayor Lowndes called the June 6, 2022, Special Council meeting to order at 6:06 pm. Staff also in attendance: Acting City Manager Reggentin, City Clerk Hollingsworth, City Attorney Shepard, Public Information Officer Sargent, Public Works Director Tracy, Finance Director Gray, Parks and Recreation Director Conn, Human Resources/Risk Management Director Gondar, Fire Chief Watts, and Police Chief Manuel.

II. DECISIONS

1. APPOINTMENT OF INTERIM CITY MANAGER

City Clerk Hollingsworth presented and stated that for the Interim City Manager, the City Charter requires that the Council appoint a City Manager as chief administrative officer with the powers and duties described in section 4.04 of the Charter. A brief discussion ensued.

The job description of Assistant City Manager Mark Reggentin requires that he perform the functions of City Manager in the absence of the City Manager. However, the Charter does not provide for one to perform as "acting City Manager," except in cases of the City Manager's "temporary absence or disability." Mr. Reggentin is able and willing to perform the duties of City Manager.

It is recommended that the City Council appoint Mark Reggentin as City Manager for an interim period with all the powers and duties appertaining to that position as described in Section 4.04 of the City Charter, provided, however, that the appointment will expire on the earlier of (1) the City Council's appointment of a City Manager of indefinite term, or (2) the day that is 180 days from today; and provided further that Mr. Reggentin's compensation during the interim period will be equal to that of the late City Manager's.

It is expected that in the coming months, the City Council will commence and conclude an appropriate search for a City Manager for an indefinite

term. It is further understood that nothing in Mr. Reggentin's appointment, including its expiration, will prejudice his employment status with the City.

After discussion, a motion was made by Councilmember Wilde to appoint Mark Reggentin as Interim City Manager for a period not to exceed 6 months and his compensation during the interim period will be equal to that of the late City Manager's. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Hall Harrison and carried by a roll call vote.
