I. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Lowndes called the Special City Council meeting of November 1, 2022 to order at 5:05pm. Staff also in attendance: Interim City Manager Reggentin, City Clerk Hollingsworth, City Attorney Shepard, Police Chief Manuel, Fire Chief Watts, Parks and Recreation Director Conn, Public Works Director Tracy, Finance Director Gray, Human Resources Director Gondar, Community Development Director Matthys, and Public Information Officer Sargent.

II. DECISIONS

1. CITY MANAGER POSITION

Mayor Lowndes introduced this item, on June 6, 2022, in accordance with the City Charter, the City Council voted unanimously to appoint Mark Reggentin, Interim City Manager for a period not to exceed six (6) months, with the understanding and expectation that the City Council would convene to direct staff regarding the City Manager position for an indefinite term.

The City Charter section 4.01 states that the City Council shall appoint a City Manager for an indefinite term and fix their compensation. The manager shall be appointed solely on the basis of their executive and administrative qualifications. The City Charter also requires that the City Council appoint a City Manager as chief administrative officer with the powers and duties described in section 4.04 of the Charter. This appointment is critical to the functioning of the City.

The staff is seeking direction from the City Council regarding the City Manager position going forward.

A discussion ensued.

Mayor Lowndes opened the public comment period.

Mike Thomas, 816 Tuscarora Trail, spoke in favor of Interim City Manager Reggentin for the City Manager position.

There being no one else who wished to speak, Mayor Lowndes closed the public comment period.

A motion was made to appoint Mark Reggentin to the position of City Manager and to authorize City Attorney Shepard to negotiate and prepare the City Manager employment contract with Mark Reggentin. The employment contract will be presented for council approval at a future meeting and to extend the previous appointment of Interim City Manager until said contract is approved and executed.
