Subject: East Central Florida Regional Resilience Collaborative		
Requested Action or Motion: Move to recommend that City Council approve the attached Resolution and Memorandum of Understanding.		
Summary Explanation & Background: Over the last several weeks, staff has been in contact with Jennifer Rupert, Regional Resilience Officer for the East Central Florida Regional Planning Council to discuss ways in which our two organizations can coordinate and collaborate on addressing issues under the umbrella of resilience, reductions in greenhouse gas production and overall issues of sustainability. In May of 2019, the East Central Florida Regional Resilience Collaborative (ECFR2C) was formally established by unanimous vote of the East Central Florida Regional Planning Council. Since then, the Regional Planning Council has been gathering data with the cooperation of it's member governments to establish a plan to meet long-term resilience objectives. Ms. Rupert will be presenting the current status of the Regional Planning Councils efforts as well as information they have gathered specific to Maitland that will assist in establishing our baseline data. The Regional Planning Council is also requesting that the city adopt a Resolution and Memorandum of Understanding endorsing and joining the East Central Florida Regional Collaboration Collaborative (attached).
