Subject: Proposed Bellamy Park Renovations		
Requested Action or Motion: N/A - Discussion Only		
Summary Explanation & Background: It is proposed as part of the Fiscal Year 2024 budget to complete renovations at Bellamy Park to the basketball court and the restrooms, both of which are in disrepair. The City is now entering into contracts with construction contractors that have recently submitted bids to be considered one of four "contractors at risk" for the City of Maitland. It will be negotiated to construct the aforementioned improvements at Bellamy Park with one of these four contractors. The City of Maitland would like to submit a Florida Recreation Development Assistant Program (FRDAP) grant application to assist with funding the Bellamy Park improvements. Staff feel that this grant application would have a good chance for success given the parameters and nature of this particular grant program. This is a discussion item only. Voting is not necessary, although questions or comments regarding the Bellamy Park improvement project or the FRDAP program are invited and encouraged.
