Summary Explanation & Background: At the February 9, 2026, City Council meeting, Council Member Guthrie proposed holding a Special Meeting of the City Council to discuss the Bylaws and Constitutions of the Lakes Advisory Board, Parks and Recreation Advisory Board, and Transportation Advisory Board. By unanimous consensus of the City Council, a Special Meeting was scheduled for Thursday, February 19, 2026, at 6:00 p.m. Attached for Council review are the Bylaws and Constitutions for boards and commissions that are not statutorily regulated (e.g., Police and Fire Pension Fund Board) or specifically required and outlined in the City Charter (Planning and Zoning Commission).
