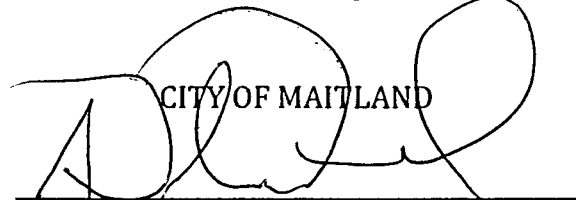

X. CITY MANAGER'S REPORT/CITY ATTORNEY/COUNCIL REPORTS

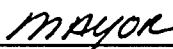
