Subject: Discussion: Park Naming Proposal (Continued from 10/6/21)

Summary Explanation & Background: In the October 6, 2021 PRAB meeting, the proposal by Mr. Rex Beech to name a park or feature of a park either "Pushpa Park or Puspa Seth Park" was discussed and debated. PRAB members were in unanimous agreement to "deny the application for the renaming of the park part of the application and move the discussion to the next meeting in regards to an alternative way to recognize Ms. Pushpa." Therefore, this discussion is intended to revisit and discuss if "alternative" recognition possibilities were appropriate in this situation. One other item of discussion in the October 6 meeting was to have three character witnesses submit statements in regards to this proposal. Those statements were submitted at the end of October and are attached for your reference. In addition, a list of all former PRAB members from the inception of PRAB to present has been included which confirms the service of Pushpa Seth as a former PRAB member. As a reminder, any park naming or park feature naming would need to be recommended by PRAB and forwarded to City Council for approval. If PRAB concluded that indeed a park feature was desired to be named after Puspa Seth, the appropriate path would be to bring this item back as a decision to the next meeting and, upon an affirmative vote, to forward the recommendation to the City Council for further approval. Staff is open for suggestions from PRAB on other "alternative" possibilities and will answer any other questions regarding this issue as much as possible.
